- *You will notice a few large brown barrels around camp. We are reclaiming rain water and using it to water and irrigate our property.
- *There is a commercial composter located near the Kamp Kitchen...help us fertilize our beautiful forest with your food scraps. Keep it out of the landfill and cut down on carbon emissions.
- *Our Kamp store is going green. Yes, you will still have all your favorites stocked, but in addition to that you will have the option to chose from a great selection of Organic Foods, Re-usable camping items, Eco-Friendly products, Green RV & Cleaning products, and Sustainable items.
- *Our campground play area has ground cover of soft fall mulch made from recycled wood pallets.
- *The sand in our volleyball court is made from recycled, tumbled, completely hazard free glass bottles!
